

Friends of Anderton and Marbury (FoAM) 2014 Photographic Competition

This is a competition for any photographic print taken in the Northwich Woodlands.

Entries are invited from photographers of all ages and abilities.

An Exhibition of all entries will be held at Comberbach Village Hall early in 2015 (date to be announced).

Winning entries may be posted on FoAM's website and published in FoAM's Newsletter.

Entry to the competition is free.

RULES

1. Entries must be submitted as prints (from film or digital cameras). They should be unmounted and a maximum size of A4 (210 x 297mm). There is no minimum size.
2. Prints will be judged in the following categories:
 - Landscape
 - Wildlife (flora or fauna)
 - Work, Rest and Play
3. Up to four of the best images in each category will be selected. The decision of the judges is final.
4. Up to three prints may be submitted per entrant. These can be all in one category or split between categories in any way.
5. Entries submitted to previous FoAM photographic competitions will be disallowed.
6. Your name, address and telephone number must be attached to every item, together with the category entered. Entries should be placed in a protective envelope and handed in, or sent, to the Rangers' Cabin at
Marbury Country Park, Comberbach, CW9 6AT.
7. The closing date for entries is 31st December 2014.

By entering, you acknowledge that you hold full copyright to the images submitted and authorise them to be used by Foam for any purpose in connection with the competition or for publicising FoAM activities.

It is the photographer's responsibility to obtain permission to include an identifiable person in any photo.

If prints are from digital media, a digital file in TIFF or JPEG format on CD or Memory Stick should be supplied with the print.

FoAM will not be responsible for loss or damage to entries.

Return post and packing must be enclosed if you would like your entry returned. Entries may also be collected from the Rangers' Cabin during November 2015 to allow for exhibitions. Entries not returned or collected may be destroyed six months after the closing date.
